DVOA is hosting a 6-hour rogaine in the Delaware Water Gap National Recreation Area on Sunday, June 5. Competitors will have 6 hours to find as many checkpoints as they can, pre-marked on the Spackman Creek and Stuckey Pond offset-printed 1:15,000 orienteering maps field checked and drafted in 2000. You may compete in either the Solo or Team category. Event headquarters will be PEEC. Orienteering sprint courses to benefit the US Orienteering Team will be offered on Saturday, June 4 in the afternoon and evening using the 1:4000 map of PEEC last used at the North American Championships in 2012. Overnight accommodations (Saturday night) are available at PEEC.

Refunds: Full refunds offered before May 10. Starting May 10, cancellations will be subject to a \$10 fee per entry.

Preview Maps: The RouteGadget site on the DVOA website (www.dvoa.org/gadget/) includes events using the Spackman Creek and Stuckey Pond maps. Alternatively, you may purchase preview maps for \$10 during on-line registration. They will be mailed if ordered on or before May 25.

Accommodations at PEEC: Cabins at PEEC are heated and have bathrooms with hot showers. Beds are wooden bunks with camp-style mattresses. You must provide your own towels and linens. Menus for dinner and breakfast are to be determined. Contact the registrar if you have specific dietary restrictions or cabin-mate requests.
